

Guidelines for the allocation of beds to students who have won the call for applications for accommodation service.

DISTRIBUTION OF BEDS IN RESIDENCES:

Following the publication of the final rankings of accommodation service for students, confirmation of Benefits for Merit in subsequent years, confirmation of Benefits for Merit first years of master's degree and subsequent years does not confirm, a distribution of the beds in the announcement will be made, among the following categories:

- A) confirmations for merit in subsequent years, confirmations for merit in the first years of a master's degree and subsequent years not confirmed (85%)
- B) first years of bachelor's degree, single-cycle master's degree and master's degree do not confirm (15%).

Under category B) there will be an additional reserve of 15% of beds for non-EU students in the first years.

For each residence, the number of beds assigned to categories A) and B) will be indicated, as well as the reservation of beds for non-EU students in the first years.

For each of the categories A) and B) a ranking list of residence assignment will be prepared according to the same criteria provided for in the "Notice for the awarding of accommodation service scholarships and degree award for the current academic year";

With equal position in the ranking, priority will be given to the student who is already a guest of the EDISU residence in the previous academic year, and if both are already guests, priority will be given to the younger student.

Every winning student in the final rankings of accommodation service will have to communicate, during the "online acceptance" phase, his assignment preferences from the list of residences, based on his category, in order of liking.

Eligible students must communicate, during the "declaration of interest" phase, their assignment preferences from a list including the residences with beds still available, based on their category, in order of liking.

Category A) will be able to choose in order of liking among the residences present at their place of study.

Category B) will be distinguished between first-year master's degree students (B1) and first-year bachelor's and single-cycle master's degree students (B2).

For category B1) the availability of beds will be in all facilities, while for category B2) students will only be able to choose the following facilities: Borsellino, Cappel Verde, Campus Sanpaolo, Campus X, CStudio, Cavour, Claretta, Codegone, Ex Moi, Olimpia, Mollino, Liborio, Lingotto, Paoli and Verdi; for the city of Novara in Castalia residence; for the city of Vercelli in Dal Pozzo and Sella residence; for the city of Cuneo in Casa Samone residence; for the city of Alessandria in Casa Sappa residence.

For the academic year 24.25 Universiade 2025:

On the occasion of the 2025 Universiade, some residences ("Olimpia", "Villa Claretta" and "Lingotto") will not be available for the period from 3rd January 2025 to 26th January 2025, therefore all assignees of the aforementioned residences will have to vacate the room.

In this regard, during the online acceptance, users requesting a bed at the Turin and Grugliasco cities be asked to proceed with the choice between the following options:

- **declares, during the online acceptance phase (winners) or declaration of interest for the bed (eligible), to independently provide alternative accommodation for the aforementioned period, in case of first choice at the structures involved for the universiade, will have the priority of assignment to one of these regardless of the position in the ranking. Furthermore, the monetization of the value of the bed space for the days of unavailability will be recognized (€8.18 for each night).**

- declares, during the online acceptance phase (winners) or declaration of interest for the bed (eligible), that they cannot independently find alternative accommodation in the aforementioned period, if assigned in one of the residences used for the universiade, by in the first days of December it will be communicated in which structure he will be welcomed for the period 3rd January 2025 to 26th January 2025

In the case of winners or eligible candidates who accept/declare interest in the bed with the "Erasmus Option", who will declare a mobility period whose start and/or end dates fall within the closing period for the Universiade and will also declare DO NOT have alternative accommodation for the aforementioned period, within the first days of December you will be notified which structure you will be accommodated in for the period 3rd January 2025 to 26th January 2025

Those who, however, declare that they have alternative accommodation for the aforementioned period and therefore vacate the assigned room will receive the monetization of the bed space (€8.18 for each night).

Upon assignment of residence, priority will be given, in the assignment of beds in the residences that will not be available for the Universiade for the period from 3rd January 2025 to 26th January 2025, to those who have declared they have alternative accommodation for the period from 3rd January 2025 to 26th January 2025 regardless of the ranking position.

Those who have been assigned to residences NOT involved in the Universiade and who have declared during the online acceptance phase (winners) or declaration of interest for the bed (eligible), to independently provide alternative accommodation, could be asked to vacate the own bed space for the aforementioned period upon payment of the unused period (€8.18 for each night).

ASSIGNMENT OF RESIDENCES:

The assignment of beds for each of the categories A) and B1/B2) will take place on the basis of the position in the ranking and on the basis of what was declared during the online acceptance or declaration of interest phase in relation to the availability or otherwise of alternative accommodation in the period of the 2025 Universiade: students will be assigned to the residence indicated as first choice until all available beds are exhausted, except for the residences used for the universiades. They will then be assigned to the other residences according to the order of preference communicated.

In order to facilitate the expression of preferences, the data relating to all the residences will be made available on the EDISU Piemonte website with particular reference to the number of beds divided into singles, doubles and triples, apartments etc., the presence of 24 hour reception and/or other services.

For non-EU students in the first years, the beds will be assigned in the same way, according to the ranking of category B), until the 15% reserve of beds is exhausted.

The same proportion must be maintained for the entire academic year, respecting the non-EU reserve percentage even when scrolling the ranking.

WINNING students already assigned a bed in the previous academic year will not have priority in the residence assignment and will enter the residence assignment ranking with all the winners. Only in case of equal scores will they be given priority.

In limited, appropriately motivated extraordinary cases (in particular for students with certified disabilities), assignments will be made in derogation of the ranking.

Motivated exceptions may also be made for students with family members or spouses who are also assigned an Edisu bed, subject to availability.

Edisu also reserves the right to change the assignment of residence as a precaution in the presence of previous particular situations.

It should be noted that as regards Erasmus Mese students, i.e. students participating in international mobility projects lasting less than 8 months or lasting less than 5 months for final semester students, they may be assigned exclusively to managed structures, for which complete list please refer to the announcement.

ROOM ASSIGNMENT (ref. art. 34 paragraph 1.1 of the notice)

The room type (single, double, triple) will be assigned based on academic seniority in ranking order and compatibly with available places. If a single room becomes available during the year, reassignment priority will be given to those who already reside in the residence itself, taking into account their academic seniority and

position in the ranking.

Male and female students over the age of 30 will be assigned a single room upon request and if the assigned residence has one.

Students with particular needs caused by health problems can obtain, upon request and if available, a single room. In this last case, students will be asked to present the relevant medical certification which explains the pathologies, the requirement for moving to a single room and the connection between it and the certified pathologies. Medical certifications drawn up in languages other than Italian must be accompanied by a translation into Italian carried out by an official translator.

EDISU Piemonte reserves the right to evaluate the medical certifications presented with particular reference to the connection between the certified pathologies and the request to move to a single room. Once the assessment has been carried out, a response will be provided to the applicant.

Requests to move to a single room accompanied by the relevant medical certification must be submitted via the ticketing service active on the website www.edisu.piemonte.it

STRUCTURE TRANSFERS (ref. art. 34 paragraph 1.2 of the notice):

Students who intend to request a transfer to another residence can request it only and exclusively for documented health reasons or for personal safety which EDISU reserves the right to evaluate, by contacting the residence service via the ticketing service active on the website www.edisu.piemonte.it

For transfers for health reasons, a medical certification must be presented in which the pathologies are explained and from which the connection between them and the request to move residence can be clearly deduced. Medical certifications drawn up in languages other than Italian must be accompanied by a translation into Italian carried out by an official translator.

EDISU Piemonte reserves the right to evaluate the medical certifications presented with particular reference to the link between the certified pathologies and the request for transfer of residence. Once the assessment has been carried out, a response will be provided to the applicant

BED EXCHANGES (ref. art. 34 paragraph 1.3 of the notice):

During the academic year, transfers between residences for bed exchange will be permitted, to be carried out in the periods indicated in the relevant exchange calendar published during the year on the website.

Interested users can make the request via the dedicated section of the Ticketing service active on the website www.edisu.piemonte.it

Requests received from each individual user will be evaluated and, based on availability, a response will be provided within five working days of the closure of the relevant exchange window.

CRITERIA FOR ALLOCATION OF BED PLACES

According to the criteria, the order of priority for assigning the type of room (single, double, etc.) is therefore the following:

1. Sixth year single cycle + additional confirmation semester
2. Sixth year single cycle + additional semester winner
3. Sixth year of a single cycle + eligible additional semester
4. Sixth year single cycle confirmation
5. Single winner sixth year cycle
6. Sixth year of single cycle eligible
7. Fifth year of single cycle + additional semester and fifth semester of confirmed master's degree
8. Fifth year single cycle + additional semester and fifth semester of the winner's master's degree
9. Fifth year of single cycle + additional semester and fifth semester of eligible master's degree
10. Fifth year single cycle and 2nd year master's degree confirmation
11. Fifth year single cycle and 2nd year master's degree winner
12. Fifth year single cycle and 2nd year eligible master's degree
13. Fourth year single cycle confirmation
14. Fourth year cycle single winner
15. Fourth eligible single cycle year
16. First year master's degree confirmed
17. First year master's degree winner
18. First year of master's degree eligible

19. Seventh semester of graduation confirmation
20. Seventh semester graduation winner
21. Eligible seventh semester of graduation
22. Third year graduation confirmation
23. Third year graduation winner
24. Third year of graduation eligible
25. Second year graduation confirmation
26. Second year graduate winner
27. Eligible second year of graduation
28. First year graduation confirmation
29. First year graduate winner
30. First year of graduation eligible

In order to guarantee compliance with the principle of "academic seniority" referred to above, the first years of bachelor's and single-cycle degrees will be assigned in double or triple rooms until they are filled.
