For all international students, regardless of their country of origin:

- **UNIFORMITY OF TREATMENT:** EDISU is committed to ensuring uniformity of treatment for all students, adapting its requests to the documentation available in each country and requesting documentation that is as closely aligned as possible with the requirements set out in the Notice of Competition and compliant with Italian law. The documentation listed in this document has been identified on the basis of the guidelines issued by the Italian Ministry of University and Research (MUR), as well as the verification and assessment activities carried out by our staff.
- **INCOMES:** Both labour and pension incomes must include any additional allowances or bonuses, as well as the thirteenth-month salary (if applicable). If the income documentation submitted indicates the total income for the relevant tax year but does not explicitly confirm that these components have been fully taken into account, or if it reports only twelve gross monthly payments, EDISU will automatically calculate the value of the thirteenth-month salary (end-year bonus mandatory by Italian law) and add it to the declared income.
- **BUILDINGS DESTROYED OR DAMAGED BY WAR OR NATURAL DISASTERS:** If one or more buildings owned by the student or the student's family have been damaged or rendered uninhabitable as a result of force majeure events, such as war or natural disasters, they may be excluded from the calculation of the applicant's real estate assets, provided that official documentation issued by the National Land Registry or the competent authority is submitted, certifying that the property has been damaged or rendered uninhabitable.
- **SPECIAL CASES (REFUGEE STATUS, TEMPORARY PROTECTION):** Students who have refugee status, are beneficiaries of temporary protection (Ukraine), or are in other circumstances provided by EDISU's Notice of Competition that preclude the inclusion of their family household, must declare their own household composition, as well as any income and assets held in Italy or in another European country. In the event of family reunification, the other members of the household must also be included in the ISEE Parificato; accordingly, they must be included in the student's household composition and declare any income and assets held in Italy or in another European country. Students belonging to these categories are strongly advised to read carefully the sections of the Call for Applications specifically dedicated to their circumstances.

SINGLE CERTIFICATE: This document contains information on household composition, income, and assets for the reference tax year. It is issued by the municipal administration of the city of residence.

HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION:

- Certificate issued by the National Civil Registry Office.
- Certificate issued by the municipality of residence in Albania or via the e-Albania Portal (MUR).

INCOMES:

- Income certification, always referring to the requested tax year, issued by the Ministry of Finance (General Directorate of Taxes; Tax Office). Also issued to self-employed professionals.
- In the case of public sector employment, certification issued directly by the relevant ministry.
- Certificates issued directly by the employer.
- Certificate issued by the Social Security Institute specifying the monthly amount on which pension contributions are paid.
- Pension: issued by the Social Security Institute (or Social Insurance). It must indicate the reference year.

UNEMPLOYMENT: document ("Aplikim për regjistrim si punëkërkes") issued by the Regional Directorate of the National Employment Service (or the employment office) certifying the individual's unemployment. The specific competent body is AKPA (Agjencia Kombëtare e Punësimit dhe Aftësive); the document available through the e-Albania portal.

INCOMES:

Preferred documentation:

- A certificate issued by the "apartment building" of residence, certifying the household composition.
- A certificate issued by the Yerevan City Hall or by the administrative district of residence.

INCOME:

- Statement from the employer specifying the year and total gross income.
- Certificate issued by the State Revenue Committee or a Tax Office.

EMPLOYMENT STATUS: The tax agency (taxpayer services) may issue a certificate "refusing" to provide a history of tax contributions for the requested period because the citizen had no income.

PROPERTY: The Land Registry Office can issue a certificate specifying the presence or absence of assets on a national basis.

Please note: The certificate issued by the Land Registry does not include the square footage; if missing, it must be supplemented with a deed of ownership or a "certificate of state registration of real property rights" that specifies it.

- Certificate issued by the Registry Office of the city of residence. It lists the personal details of the household members and their family relationships. This is a civil registry document that should also reflect any divorces or deaths.
- Certificate issued by the Public Services Agency (ASAN), under the Ministry of Justice
- Certificate of residence listing cohabiting family members and their family relationships; issued by municipal offices

INCOMES:

- Certificate issued by the employer (public or private) specifying monthly and annual income totals
- E-GOV certificate

Pension: Pension certificate, issued by the Ministry of Labor and Social Security with annual figures.

UNEMPLOYMENT: Unemployment is also certified through a document issued by the "State Employment Service at the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection"; it may indicate that no active employment contract was found for the requested period.

Please note: Sometimes, in the translation, this document states that the individual is "not registered as a job seeker". This is not acceptable. Please pay attention to the way the document is translated.

The office reserves the right to evaluate other forms of proof of income on an individual basis, such as:

UNEMPLOYMENT: Carteira de Trabalho Digital (Digital Work Card) ISSUED BY THE Carteira de Trabalho Digital portal/app (gov.br). This is the most reliable document. It shows the history of all jobs held, with start and end dates for each contract. The "gaps" between one job and another indirectly demonstrate periods of unemployment.

PROPERTIES:

- Within the "Imposto Sobre a Renda" form, if property tax is due, the relative properties and their area in square meters must be specified.
- Certificate of property ownership/non-ownership issued by the Cartório de registro de imóveis (Real Estate Registry Office).

- **INCOME STATEMENT "Etat récapitulatif pour ... ":** *indicates the income received in each month of the reference year issued by the Ministère des Finances (MINFI).*

UNEMPLOYMENT:

- **Certificat de non fonction:** *certificate of unemployment. To be submitted if the unemployment of one or more parents is reported.*

- *"Attestation d'inscription en qualité de demandeur d'emploi" and the corresponding registration certificate with the FNE ("Attestation d'inscription au FNE"), issued by the Ministère de l'Emploi et de la Formation Professionnelle (MINEFOP) and the Fonds National de l'Emploi (FNE).*

PROPERTIES: *Titre Foncier issued by the Ministère des Domaines, du Cadastre et des Affaires Foncières (MINDCAF), through the Conservation Foncière. All properties must be declared.*

SUPPLEMENTS TO HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION:

- "Contribution certificate" issued by the insurance company showing the income on which pension contributions are paid, with annual and monthly references.

PROPERTIES:

- Tax information certificate regarding ownership of real estate, issued by the Internal Revenue Service (Servicio de Impuestos Internos, SII). The properties' area in square meters must be specified.
- Property details may also be included in the "socioeconomic profile" document, specifying the square footage.

ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTATION:

HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION: A notarized certificate attesting family relations, listing the personal details of the household members. There are certificates covering both separation/divorce and death.

INCOMES: A certificate of earned income issued directly by the employer or the organization where the individual works; it may refer to the tax year or to single months within the tax year.

Pension:

Certificate issued by the company/institution where the individual previously worked, specifying that the individual is now retired (the annual or monthly amount and the reference to the tax year are indicated);

UNEMPLOYMENT: Unemployment certificate issued by the Employment Services Center. It indicates the date from which the individual has been unemployed; please ensure that this covers the period required by the call for applications.

PROPERTIES: Certificate of home ownership issued by the Ministry of Construction of the PRC, specifying the properties' area in square meters. **Please note:** No national land registry exists; individual property deeds are accepted provided they are legalized and translated.

ABSENCE OF PROPERTIES: "Consultation of data on property and real estate" issued by the "City Real Estate Property Registration Center," or the "Center for the Issuance of Real Estate Property Registration Certificates and Real Estate Sales."

Pension: retirement letter issued by the employer; it must indicate the annual gross retirement income for the reference year.

PROPERTIES:

1. The DIAN document includes details of taxes related to assets. However, it does not specify whether these are movable or immovable assets, nor does it specify the surface area of the properties; in this case, the student must submit the certificate issued by the Land Registry specifying the real estate properties' area in square meters.
2. Property tax return specifying the properties' area in square meters.
3. Local land registry certificate specifying the properties' area in square meters.
